The Reign of Queen Victoria

Queen Victoria was born at Kensington Palace in London in 1819. At the age of 18 she became Queen of Great Britain and Ireland, also Empress of India in 1837. 3 years after that, in 1840, at the age of 21, she married her cousin, Albert of Saxe-Coburg Gotha.

In 1861, her beloved husband died at the age of 42, Queen Victoria had been married 21 years and mourned her husband's death for 10 years. She wore black for the rest of her days. She had 9 children, 37 grand children and **40** great-grandchildren. Living for an impressive 82 years, having been Britain's longest ever ruling monarch- 63 years, 7 months and 2 days.



She died in 1901 on 22nd January; She was finally buried in Windsor.
