So why did you let me die?



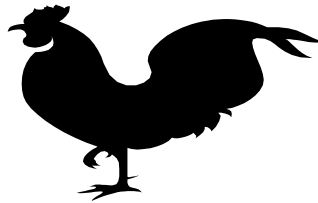
Poems

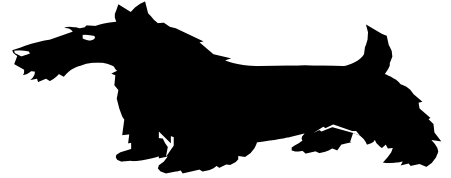
The Ladybird
