Welcome back! Here are a few bits of information that you will need this summer term.

## <u>Staffing</u>

Mrs Stubbs is the Pre School Teacher on a Monday to Wednesday, and Mrs Portch leads provision on a Thursday and Friday. Miss Storer will also be supporting us within the classroom.

## <u>Timings of the day</u>

Snacks will be provided during both sessions. You are welcome to provide your own but we would ask that this something healthy and easily consumed. All children will need a

### Forest School

Our Forest School session will resume on a Friday morning, led by Mrs North. We have plenty of waterproof over clothes for the children to use but we would be grateful if all children had a pair of wellies with them on this day, and are wearing warm, suitable clothing. Please be aware that the children may come home a little messy so please send them in on this day in something you do not mind getting muddy.

### <u>Curriculm</u>

Our topic this half term is 'Big and Small' and we will be learning about different animals, including mini beasts and ocean creatures. We will be looking at how some animals grow and change, such as a caterpillar and a tadpole, and also growing some big flowers from tiny seeds. Our older children will be starting Read, Write, Inc Phonics and learning to recognise some letters and the sounds that they make.

## Reading

We also have lots of fabulous stories to read over the next few weeks. We place a huge importance on sharing stories and make sure that our children hear at least two stories a day. Our stories are all carefully chosen to develop vocabulary and to engage our children and foster a love of reading. This term's texts include:
