Welcome back after our summer break, we hope you all had a fun summer!

Our theme for this half term is “My Body”

The following is a run-down of how we will be exploring this theme as well as the aims and objectives we will be concentrating on in other curriculum areas:

Understanding English, Communication and Language

Communication group: focusing upon building relationships with new staff, listening to others, learning new and remembering previous routines, cooperating and interacting with peers, making requests and describing objects.

My Body

To know the names of different body parts.

To know what parts of our bodies we use for different activities.

To know that humans get the nutrition they need from what they eat.

To explore human and animal skeletons

To know about how the skeleton supports and protects the body and to investigate how invertebrates are supported.

To know what muscles are and how skeletal muscles help us to move

To know the different types of teeth in humans and identify their functions



- To know different ways of keeping teeth healthy.**
- To know how the digestive system works**
- To know how to describe the functions of the basic parts of the digestive system**

Understanding the Arts

Art – Drawing – Bodies

- **To know how to create different types of lines**
- **To explore line and mark making to draw bodies.**
- **To draw with different media**
- **To develop an understanding of mark making**
- **To apply an understanding of drawing materials and mark making to draw from observation.**

Children will be learning these specific skills as well as creating a range of art linked to our current theme.

Throughout the second half of the Autumn term, children will engage in a variety of seasonal art and crafts linked to Halloween, Diwali, Bonfire night and Christmas.

Understanding Physical Development

PE – Skills and Movement

- **Be able to move showing good agility, balance and co-ordination**
- **To further develop the fundamentals of movement**
- **To understand what balance is**
- **To be able to replicate and develop rolling techniques**
- **To be able to replicate the rolling action while aiming at a target**
- **To be able to develop a bouncing technique**
- **To be able to demonstrate the correct technique for bouncing a ball**
- **To understand the key points for catching**
- **To be able to replicate a catching technique**
- **To develop a technique for underarm throws**
- **To be able to use an underarm throw technique to hit targets**
- **To develop a technique for overarm throws**
 - **To be able to use the overarm throw technique with accuracy**

RE – Celebrations and Festivals – Harvest

- express creatively their response to a celebration
