- To know who Edward Jenner was and what he achieved.
- To know who William Wilberforce was and what he achieved.
- To know about the lives of heroic explorers and adventurers throughout History.

Understanding the Arts

Art - Exploring Sculptures

- To draw using shading for light and dark.



- To apply paper-shaping skills to make an imaginative sculpture.
- To work collaboratively to plan and create a sculpture.
- To apply painting skills when working in 3D.
- To roll paper/use papier mâché to make 3D structures.
- To know how to use mosaic skills to create a picture.

Children will be learning these specific skills as well as creating a range of art linked to our current theme.

Understanding Physical Development

PE - Athletics

- To discover different ways to use a hoop.
- To know different ways to run including changing direction.
- To demonstrate and improve running techniques
- To know different ways to jump.
- To demonstrate and improve running, skipping and jumping techniques
- To know how to aim and hit a target.
- Throw different balls - practice throwing and catching techniques.

Show an understanding of different events within athletics.

P.E day is Thursday: Please can your child have their P.E kit at school - shorts, T-shirt and plimsolls.

- To know what a place of worship is.
- To discuss key parts of a Jewish synagogue.
- To discuss key parts of a Hindu Mandir.
- To discuss key parts of a Christian church.
- To discuss why places of worship are important in religions.
